Grosse Ile Toll Bridge Limits and Restrictions

Weight Limit

- 50 ton gross, 8 ton per axle (all axles must be down).

Clearance

- 14 feet.

Procedures for Large Trucks (Class 3 through Class 6 Vehicles)

- Large trucks must travel with all axles down and limit their speed to 15 mph while on bridge.

Oversized Vehicle Procedures

- Vehicles carrying oversized loads -- over 8 1/2 feet wide -- are not permitted to cross the bridge during morning (6 a.m. to 10 a.m.) and afternoon (3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m.) weekday rush hours. Vehicles with oversized loads may only cross the bridge between 10 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. or between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m.
- Oversized vehicles are not permitted on the Toll Bridge when the Wayne County Bridge is closed.
- Vehicles carrying oversized loads must call the Grosse Ile Police Department at (734) 676-7100 to make arrangements to cross the bridge.

User Fee Toll Fares for Large Trucks (Class 3 through Class 6 Vehicles)

- The cash fare for large trucks (Class 3 through Class 6 Vehicles) is \$3 per axle for a one-way trip (note that SUVs, pickup trucks and non-commercial vans are Class 1 Vehicles).

Bridge Pass Express Lane

- Vehicles without a Bridge Pass are prohibited from using the Bridge Pass Express Lane. Vehicles with a Bridge Pass may use the Attended Lane or the Bridge Pass Express Lane.

Pedestrians

- No pedestrians are permitted on the Toll Bridge.
