







Grosse Ile Toll Bridge One-way Crossing User Fee Toll Fares

General Rules on Payment of the User Fee Toll Fare

- One-way toll fares are collected from eastbound and westbound traffic except when the Wayne County Bridge is closed. During County Bridge closures, a round-trip toll fare will be collected from eastbound traffic.
- Bridge Passes are available for all vehicle classes except Class 2 (vehicles with trailers pay with cash or credit card).
- Tokens can only be used to pay for crossings in a Class 1 vehicle (i.e., car, SUV, pickup truck, van or motorcycle).
- Bridge Passes or tokens cannot be used when pulling a trailer (vehicles with trailers pay with cash or credit card).
- Bicycles are not charged for crossings. Pedestrians are not permitted on the bridge.
- All county, state and federal government-owned vehicles pay regular toll fares for their vehicle class.

Information on Purchasing a Bridge Pass or Roll of Tokens

Price for a Bridge Pass (lowest fare - save time and money):

For Class 1 vehicles, the Bridge Pass requires the purchase of \$40 in pre-paid toll fares and a \$25 refundable deposit. Prices and deposit requirements vary for other vehicle classes (not available for Class 2 vehicles). Price for a Roll of Tokens:

\$45 for a roll of 24 tokens plus a one-way crossing at the time of purchase. A limit of one roll of tokens may be purchased per crossing at the toll plaza. No refunds for purchases of tokens.

Where to Buy a Roll of Tokens or Bridge Pass:

Tokens and Bridge Pass applications are available in the toll booth at the toll plaza 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
